Notes:

- 1) A separate #1050 Candleholder insert was made for the 4½" Type 1 Swan in Crystal, Emerald (Light), Peach-blo, and Ebony.
- 2) The 4½" Type 3 Swans in Crystal and Milk were also made with an integrally molded candleholder, also identified as the #1050.
- 3) A separate cover was made for the Emerald (Light) 8½" Type 1 Swan to become the #1048 - Candy Box & Cover. It had feather detail, but no knob. Around 1937 or just before, the mold was reworked. Feather detail was removed and a place for a Rose Knob was added. Using the Type 2 - 8½" Swan, this became the #1492 - Candy Box & Cover. It was produced in Crystal and Moonlight.
- 4) Separate #1052 flower pot inserts, were made for the #1044 - 10" Type 1 Swans in Crystal, Emerald (Light), Peach-blo and Ebony.
- 5) Amber Swans vary greatly in color intensity. No documentation exists of swans produced in either Madeira or Mocha.
- 6) Although listed as 16" by Cambridge, the #1221 Swan Punch Bowl measures approximately 13".
