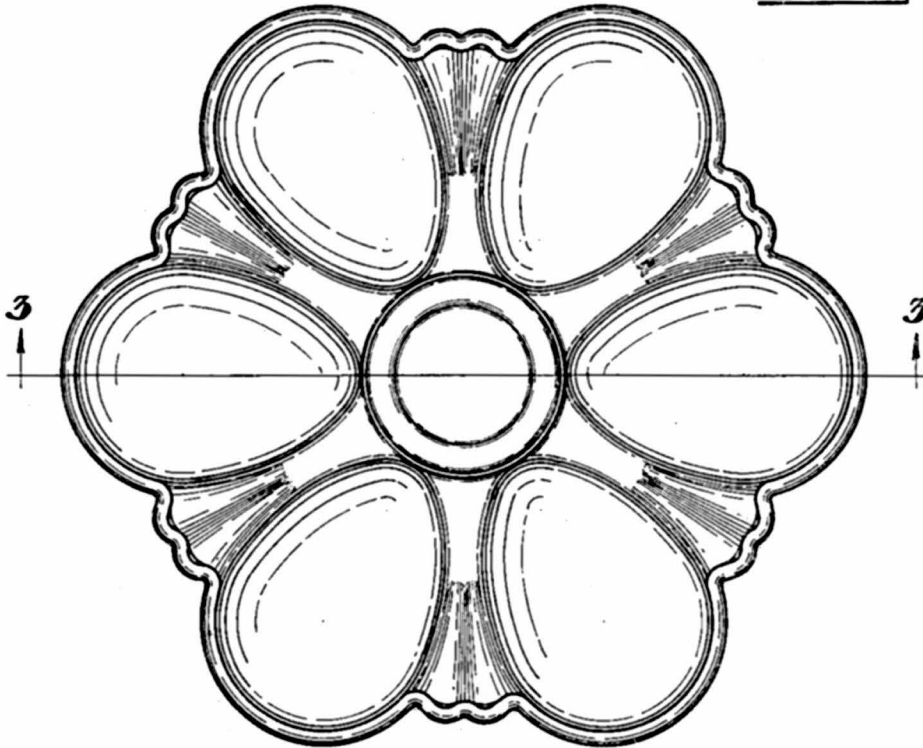

DESIGN FOR AN OYSTER SERVER PLATE OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Arthur J. Bennett, a citizen of the United States of America and resident of Cambridge, county of Guernsey, and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Oyster Server Plate or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming part thereof, in which—

Figure 1 is a top plan view of an oyster server

plate or similar article, showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a side elevational view of the same; and

Figure 3 is a vertical sectional view taken on line 3—3 of Fig. 1.

I claim—

The ornamental design for an oyster server plate or similar article, substantially as shown.
