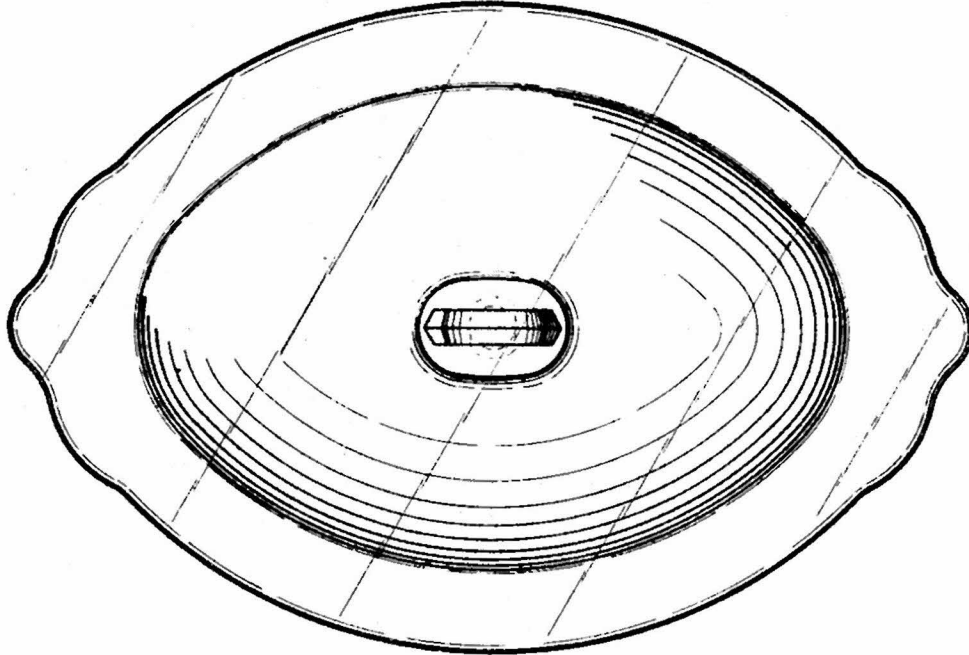
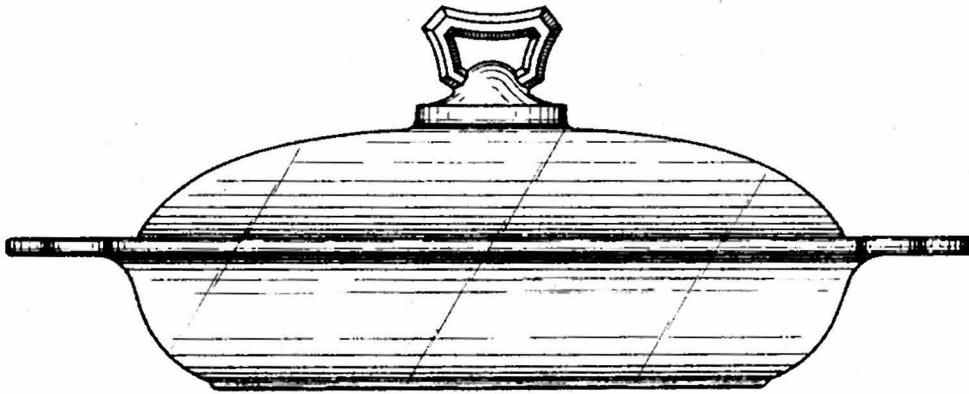

DESIGN FOR A COVERED DISH.

Application filed November 8, 1926. Serial No. 19,636. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ARTHUR JAMES BENNETT, a citizen of the United States of America, and resident of Cambridge, county of Guernsey, and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Covered Dish, of which the following is a specification, reference being had
