

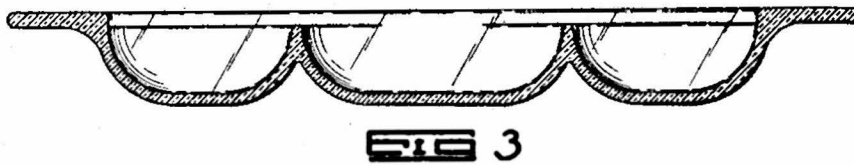
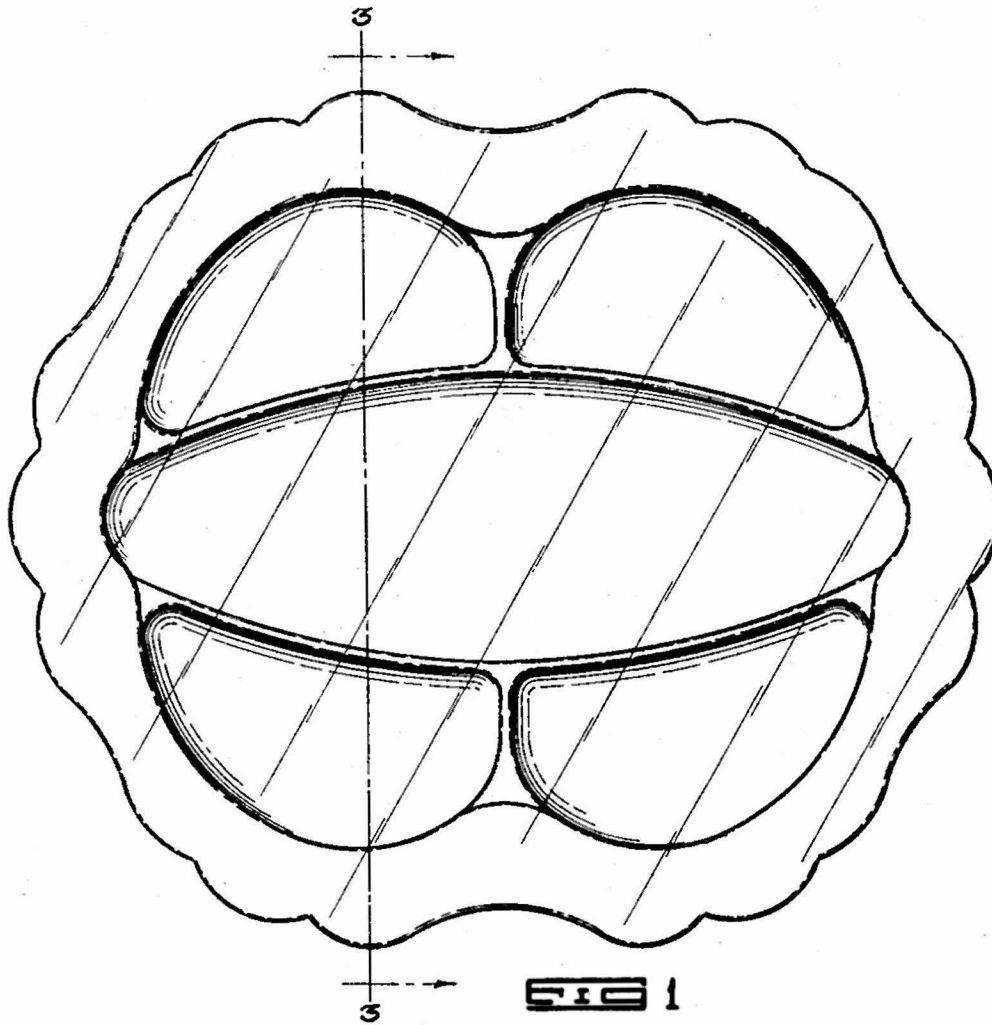

DESIGN FOR A GLASS RELISH TRAY OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JESS CLAIR KELLY, a citizen of the United States of America, and resident of Cambridge, county of Guernsey, and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Glass Relish Tray or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, in which—

Figure 1 is a plan view of a glass relish

tray or similar article, showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a side elevation of the same; and—

Figure 3 is a section on line 3—3, Fig. 1.
