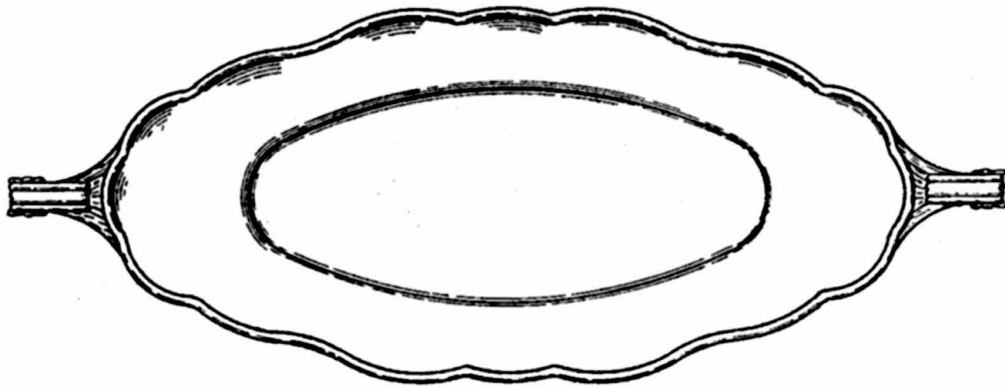

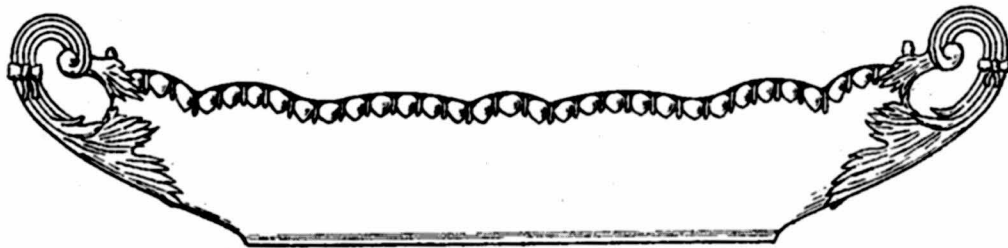

JESS CLAIR KELLY, OF CAMBRIDGE, OHIO

DESIGN FOR A CELERY TRAY OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed November 6, 1931. Serial No. 41,640. Term of patent 3½ years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, JESS CLAIR KELLY, a citizen of the United States of America, and resident of Cambridge, county of Guernsey, and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Celery Tray or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, in which—

Figure 1 is a top plan view of a celery tray or similar article showing my new design; and—

Figure 2 is a side elevation of the same.

I claim—

The ornamental design for a celery tray or similar article substantially as shown.
