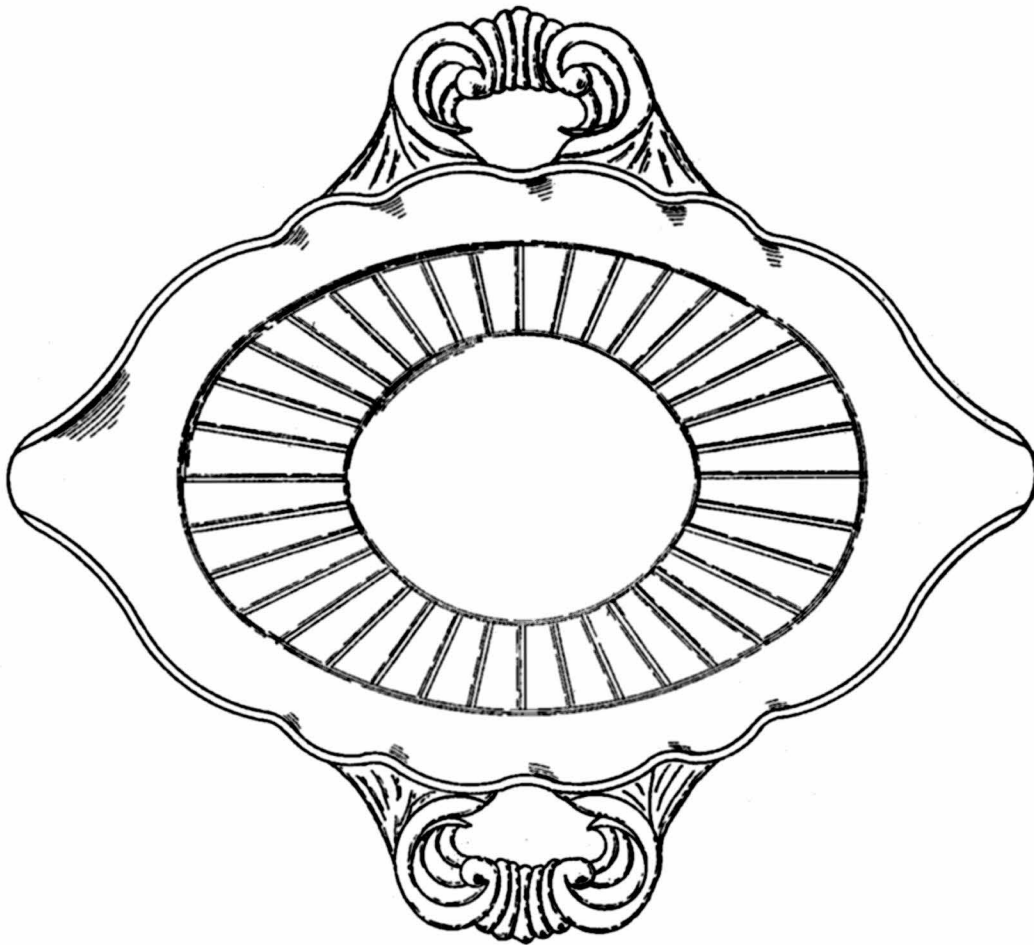

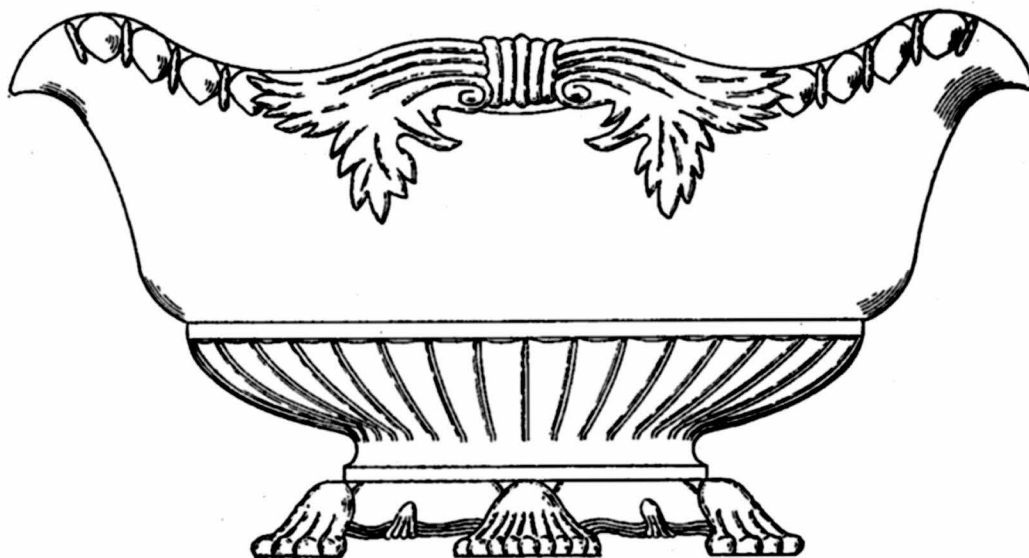

DESIGN FOR A MAYONNAISE DISH OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed November 6, 1931. Serial No. 41,641. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JESS CLAIR KELLY, a citizen of the United States of America, and resident of Cambridge, county of Guernsey, and State of Ohio, have invented a new original, and ornamental Design for a Mayonnaise Dish or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, in which—

Figure 1 is a top plan view of a mayonnaise dish or similar article showing my new design; and—

Figure 2 is a side elevation of the same.
