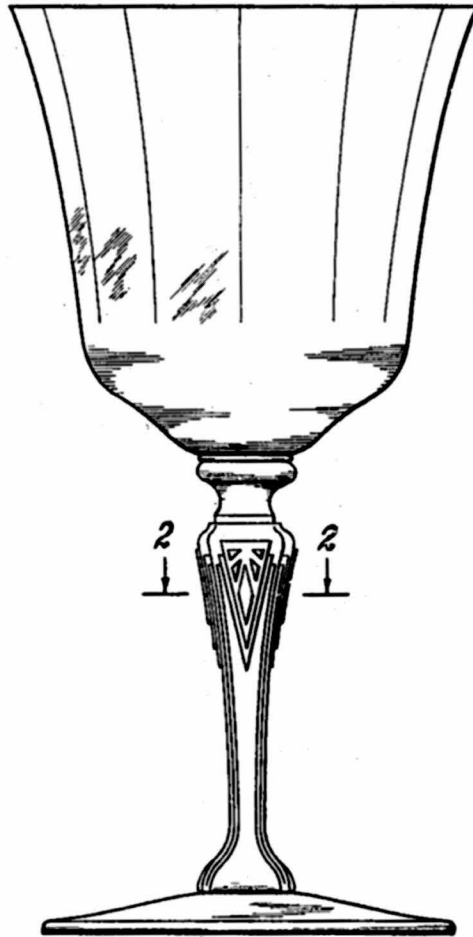
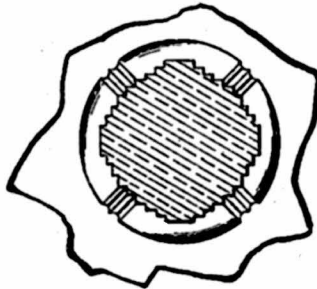

DESIGN FOR A GOBLET OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed December 24, 1931. Serial No. 42,190. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, RAY T. KIMBLE, citizen of the United States, residing at Cambridge, county of Guernsey, State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Goblet or Similar Article, fully described and represented in the following specification and the accompanying drawings, forming a part of the same, in which—

Figure 1 is a side elevation of the goblet or similar article, showing my new design; and

Figure 2 is a cross-section taken on the line 2—2 of Figure 1.

The essential feature of my new design is the ornamental matter on the stem of the goblet or similar article.

The ornamental design for a goblet or similar article as shown and described.
